2024 was the second year of our Bigger, Bolder, Better strategic plan, and it certainly was a Bigger, Bolder, Better year for Angel Foundation[™]. Emergency Financial Assistance saw a 26% year-overyear increase, awarding more money than ever before. Financial Cancer Care also had a record year, providing financial education to 276 clients, valued at \$1.6 million. We served 1,809 individuals and provided \$10,000 in donated tickets through our Adult & Family Programs, giving families the opportunity to enjoy time together.

We're proud that in 2024 we served 3,679 unique clients—our biggest year yet. Grow, Advance, and Build, the three pillars of our strategic plan, shaped Angel Foundation's™ work this year as we advanced our mission to unlock our potential.

In 2024, we grew our service area to include Olmsted County, home to Rochester and Mayo Clinic, serving 331 people across our programs. We also served 345 people in St. Louis County (home to Duluth). Our Mission Delivery team diversified our referral sources beyond hospitals and clinics, ensuring clients can access our services. We saw a 15% increase in service to underserved communities in 2024.

> Building our capacity to deliver enhanced and expanded services, Angel Foundation™ partnered with Allianz Life Insurance to provide employees with Angel Packs™ as a wellness benefit, further diversifying our revenue portfolio. To ensure sustainable growth of both our programs and fund development efforts, Angel Foundation™ added two positions to our staff: Program Coordinator Ka Zoua Xiong and Leadership Giving Officer Aleah Van Horne.

While there is much to celebrate from 2024, demand for Angel Foundation's™ services only continues to grow. We are focused on continuing to advance our mission in the final year of our strategic plan, while also thinking big about our next strategic plan and what the years to come will look like for Angel Foundation™ as we continue to unlock our potential to best serve Minnesota's cancer patients and their families.

Monetary support, volunteering, and committee membership are vital and visible avenues through which supporters of Angel Foundation[™] enable us to serve cancer patients across Minnesota. However, the healthcare workers, social workers, and patient navigators in oncology clinics play an equally important role. These professionals connect patients to Angel Foundation[™] as they undergo treatment. In fact, most of the clients Angel Foundation[™] serves are referred by these dedicated people.

One such example is Jane, a social worker who referred more patients to Angel Foundation[™] in 2024 than anyone else. During a conversation with Jane, she shared that she always keeps Angel Foundation[™] top of mind when meeting with new patients. By asking thoughtful questions about a patient's financial stability, family dynamics, and whether they are working with a financial planner, Jane gains a fuller picture of their situation and can identify how they might benefit from Angel Foundation's[™] programs.

When asked why she thought she was our top referrer, Jane explained that she takes pride in helping cancer patients in all areas of their lives. Her holistic approach ensures that patients not only receive the medical care they need but also the critical support that helps them navigate the challenges of cancer treatment. "The thing I love about working with cancer patients is that every patient's story is different. Their lives are complicated, and made more difficult by cancer, but they do not let that get them down. They show up for their responsibilities and stay resilient. The least I can do is connect them with Angel Foundation[™] to help them through another day, week, or month."

Looking Ahead

As we enter the final year of our Bigger, Bolder, Better strategic plan, we continue to think Bigger, Bolder, and Better to meet the needs of our clients. In 2025, Angel Foundation™ is introducing nutrition education workshops and one-on-one sessions with registered dietitians to further address what has become one of our clients' biggest concerns—access to easy, healthy, affordable meals during their cancer treatment. We are delivering Angel Packs™ statewide, and they can also now be purchased for families impacted by a cancer diagnosis living outside of our service area.

It is hard to believe that in 2018 we served 2,600 patients and by the end of 2025 we will have served 4,200 in a single year. That is a 62% increase over three years.

In 2026, Angel Foundation[™] will celebrate our 25th anniversary. As we begin to reflect on all Angel Foundation[™] has accomplished in our first 25 years, our Horizon Committee has been looking ahead to what we want Angel Foundation[™] to accomplish over the next 10 years. As we close out our Bigger, Bolder, Better strategic plan, we know that our next strategic plan, currently in development, will be the first steppingstone towards our goal of becoming Minnesota's premier cancer resource by our 35th anniversary.
