What We Do

Emergency Financial Assistance

Angel Foundation provides emergency financial assistance to adults in active treatment for cancer in the seven-county metro area of the Twin Cities to meet critical non-medical needs such as housing payments, food, utilities and transportation costs. Statistics show that 40 percent of cancer patients will fall below the poverty level sometime during their treatment.

Each year, Angel Foundation's Emergency Financial Assistance program grants over \$1 million in emergency funds.

Facing Cancer Together

Through this program, Angel Foundation offers education and support free of charge to families with children and teens who have a parent with cancer. Statistics show that 25 percent of adults with cancer have school-age children. The Facing Cancer Together program helps the whole family, because cancer affects the whole family. The program helps families gain understanding, strength and hope as they face the challenges of cancer together.



Facing Cancer Together programs include:

- Education and Support Series — a four-week program for parents, caregivers and children/teens, who meet individually in peer groups to participate in therapeutic activities to help them manage the cancer in their families.
- Camp Angel — a three-day camp for children 5-18 that offers fun, peer support and strength-building.
- Family Retreats — day-long education and support retreats for the entire family.
- Teen Outreach — monthly activities and special projects for teens who have a parent with cancer.
- AngelPacks — therapeutic backpacks for each family member given when a parent with school-age children is diagnosed with cancer.
