After two years of measuring our Financial Cancer Care program we are introducing a workshop to help participants impacted by cancer start to build a financial plan. The Financial Cancer Care workshop is an introductory virtual course instructed by a Volunteer Certified Financial Planner™ and Social Worker is about how to “Get Your Financial House” in order when cancer strikes. This program reviews ways to plan a budget, build a savings plan, plan for retirement, and to start a financial roadmap to help participants feel more confident in their financial knowledge and skills when cancer strikes.
